

How to make an Actual Size (27"x8") copy of the Class Photo (on the cheap)

This is Page 1 which you don't need to print.
Pages 2 thru 4 break up the Class Photo as follows:

There is overlap between pages which will aid in the aligning and pasting/taping of the photo.

I recommend printing pages in Draft print mode (not Normal or Best) until you get familiar with your printer settings and the resulting output.

Since printers and PDF programs differ in their options and results - all I can do is make some recommendations here:

Paper Size: A4 or Letter (and probably borderless)

May have to switch from Portrait to Landscape mode.

Good Luck - Have Fun - Hope your ink don't cost much. (Actually I got resonable results staying in Draft mode)
