## SENIOR BREAKFAST

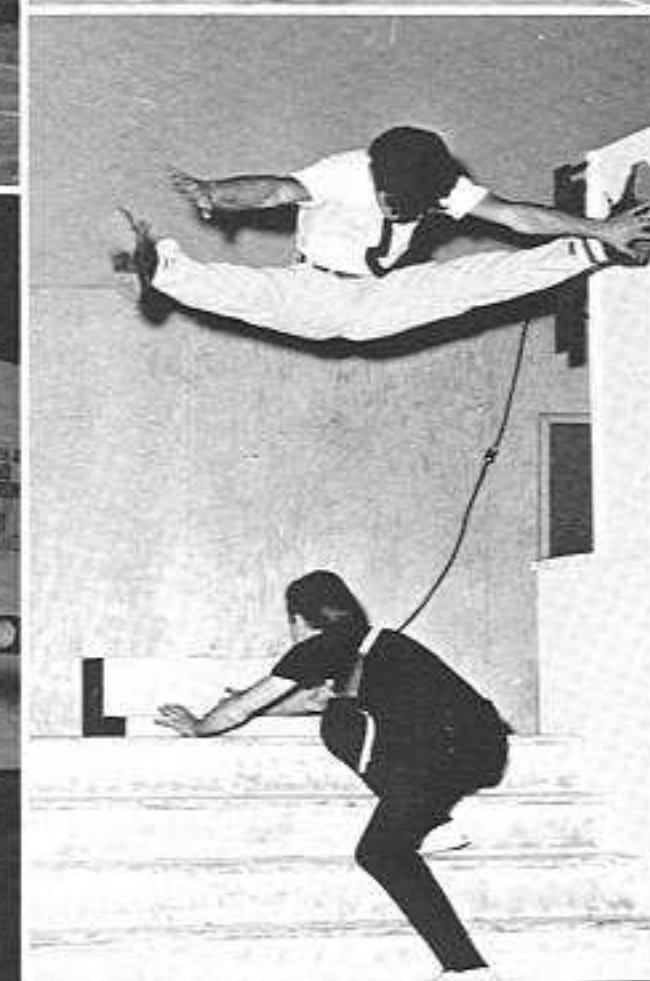

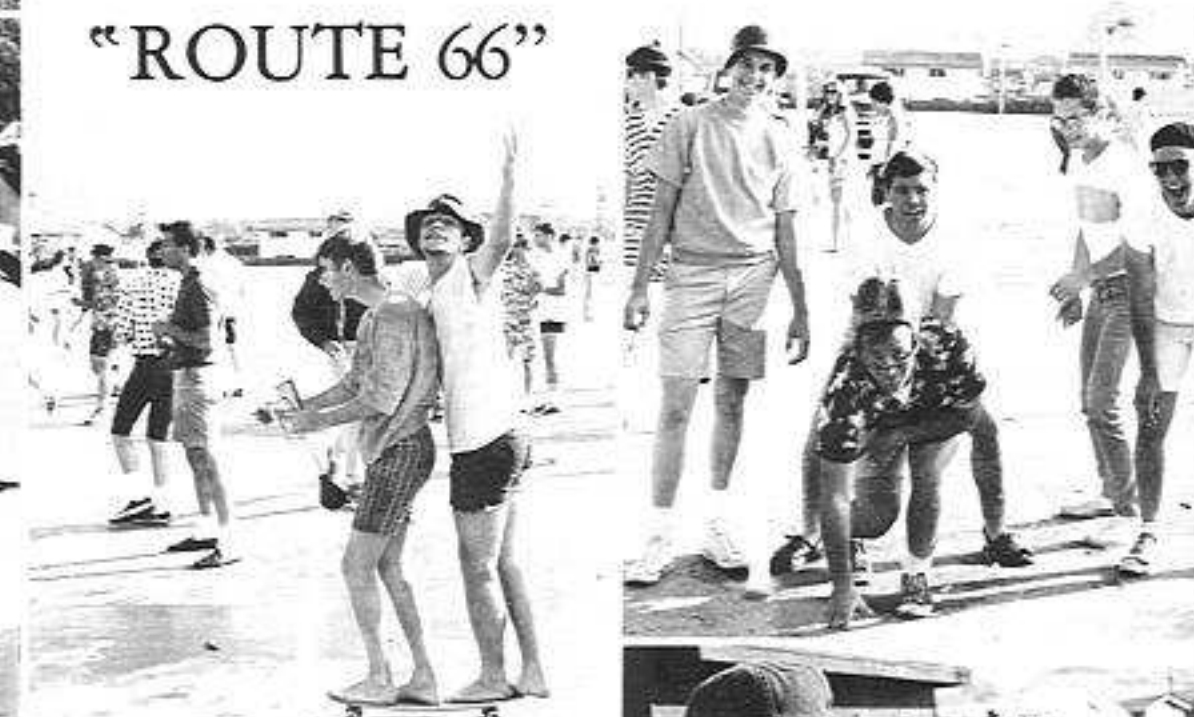
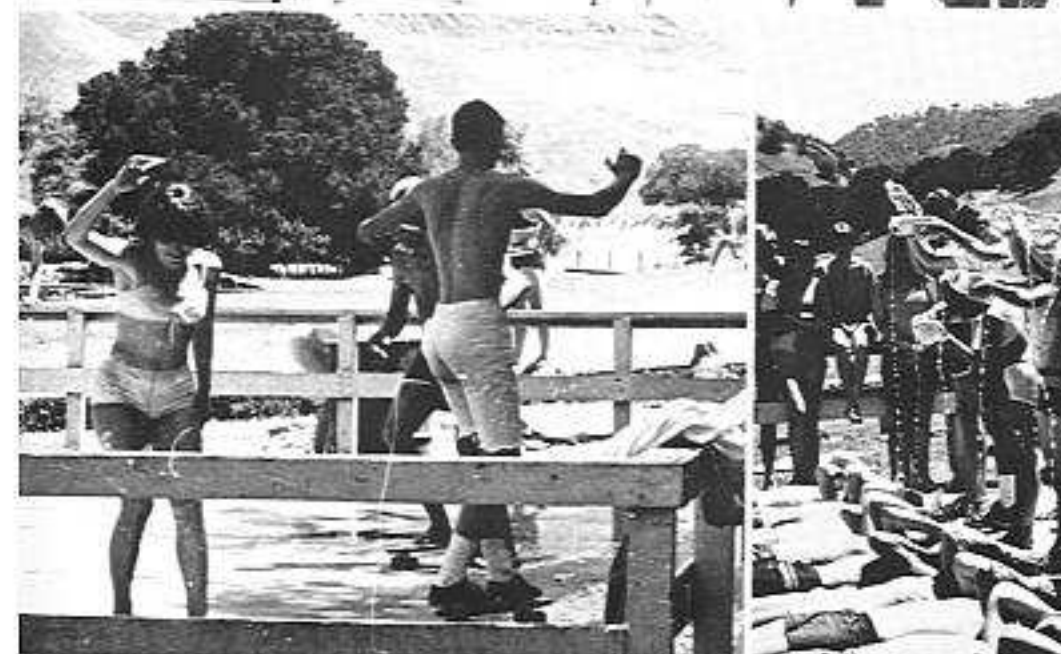
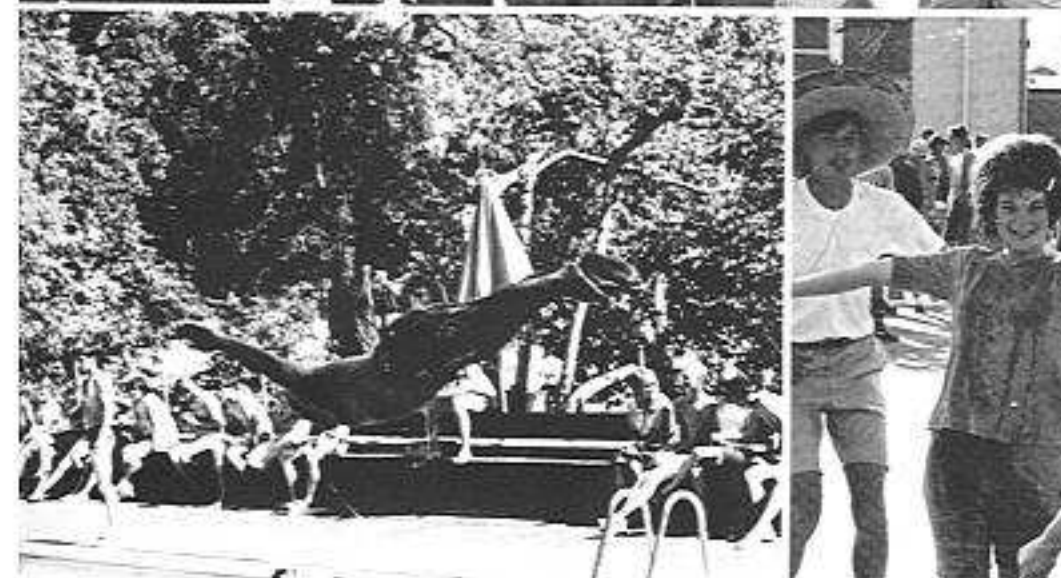
# SENIOR PICNIC

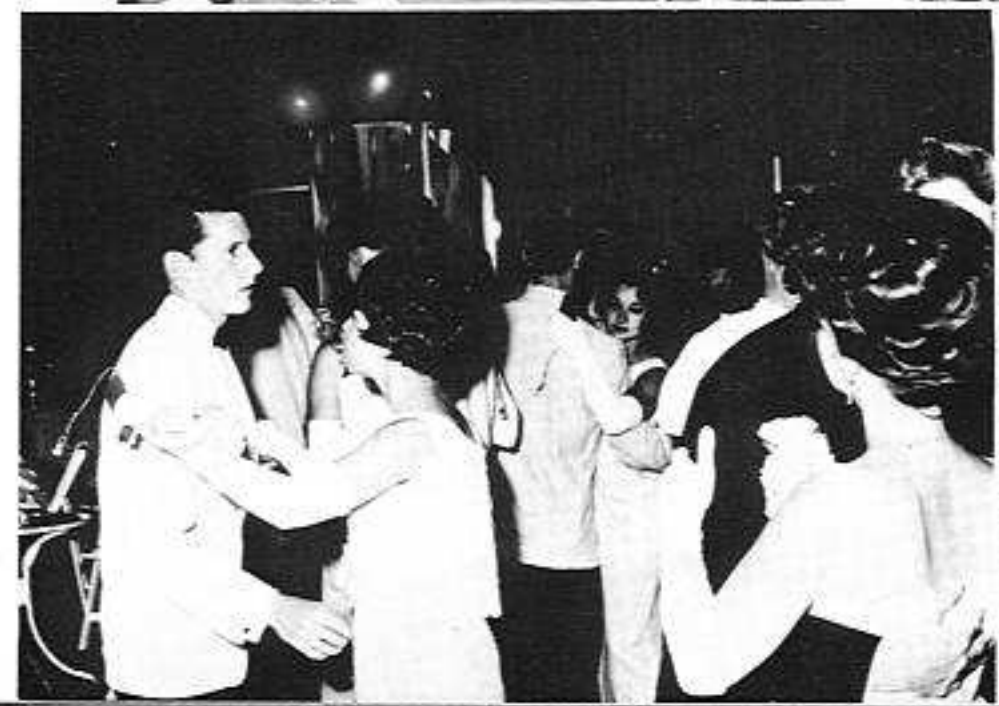
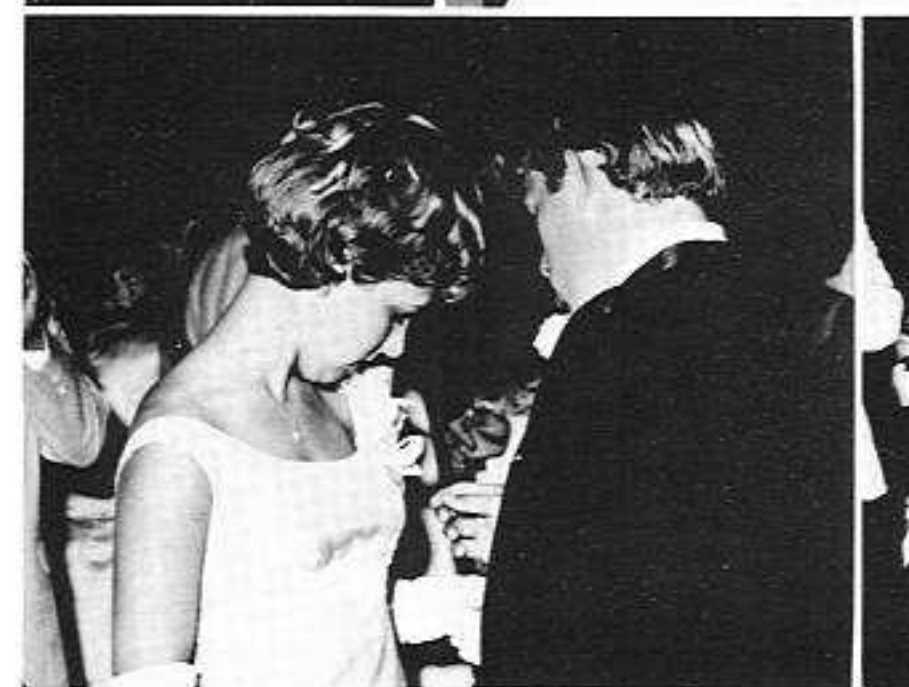
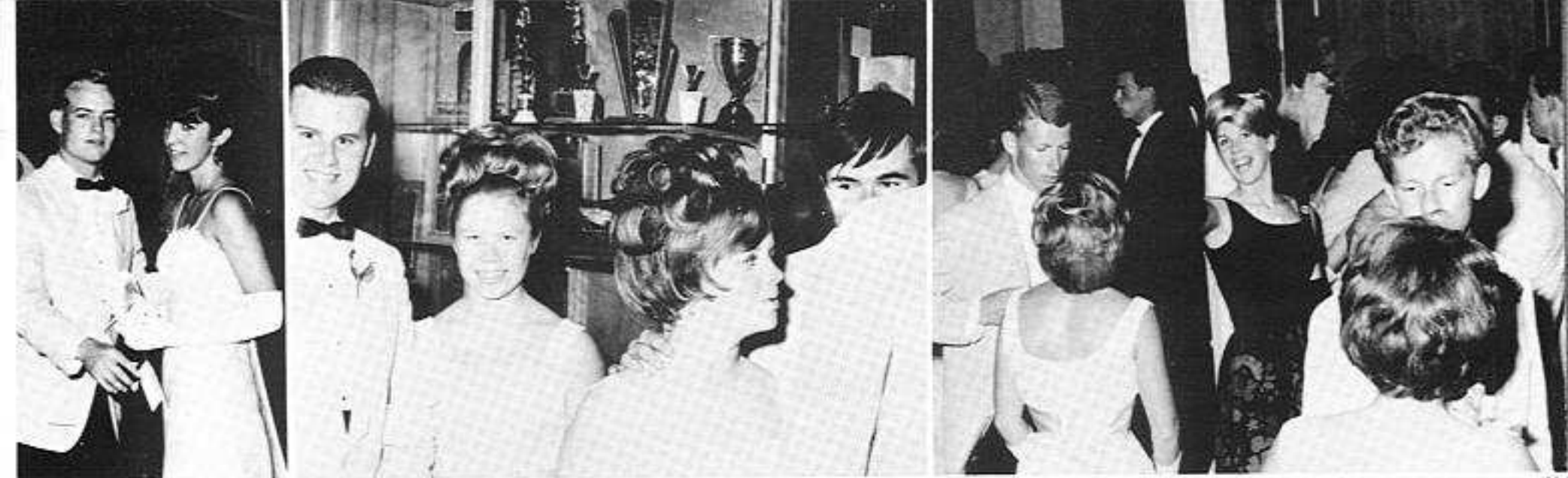


# SENIOR BANQUET

# BACCALAUREATE and GRADUATION

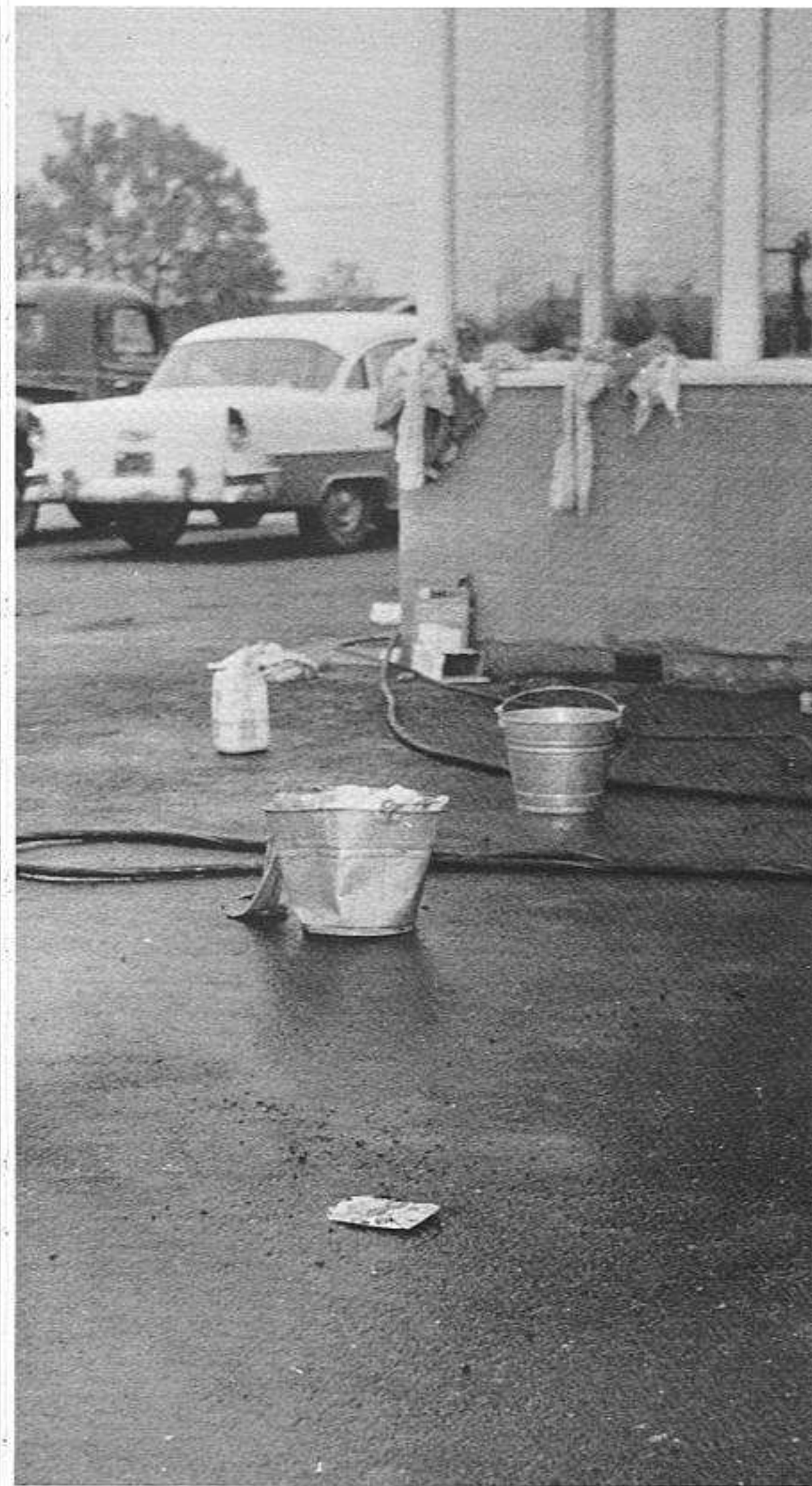

Thank you Juniors for three full years of strength, service, and spirit.

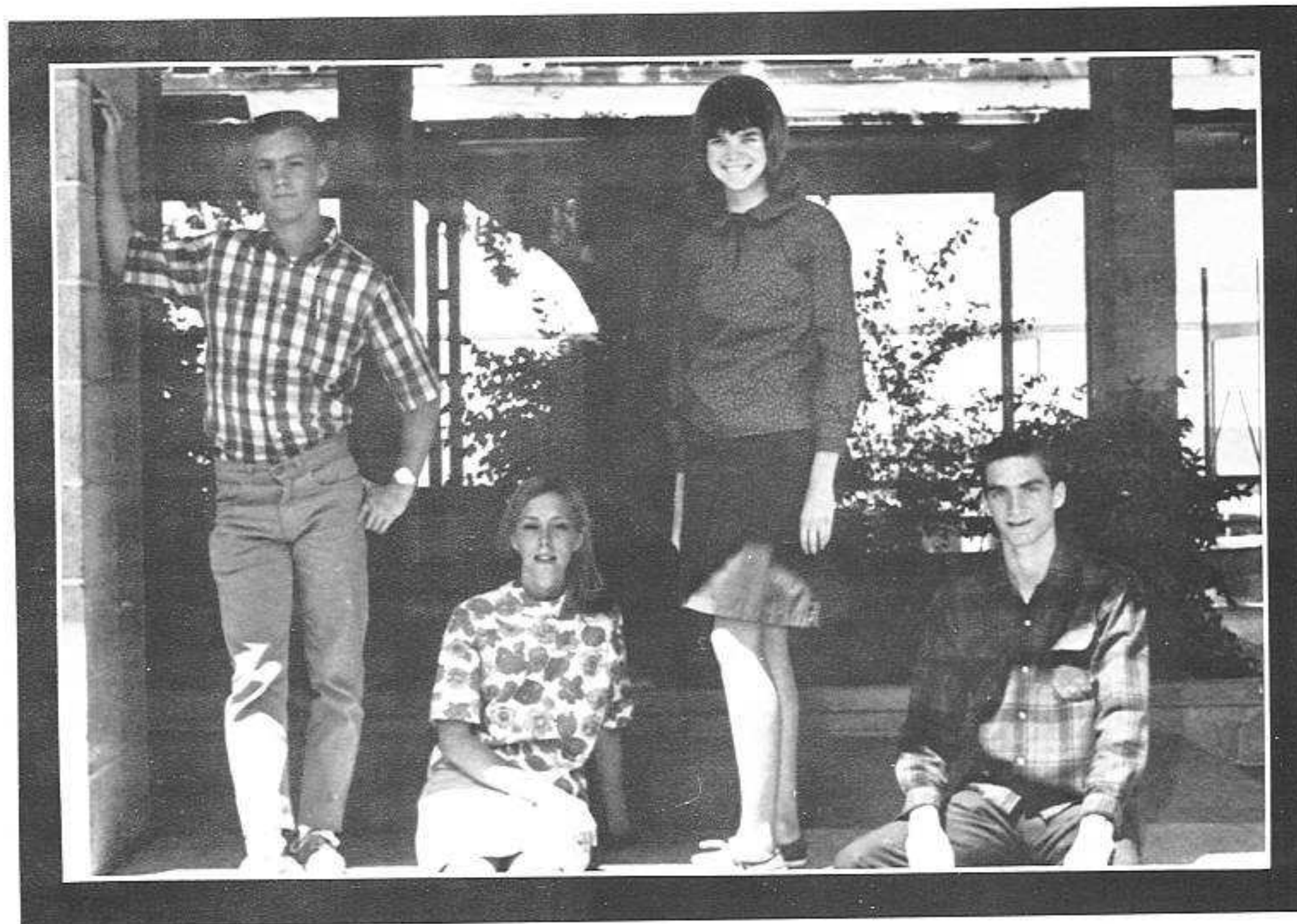
