






Other activities that were enjoyed were the outstanding senior side show and the tug-o-war between the Juniors and the Seniors. Which was won by the Senior class.

Pop music was piped to the field provided by Clayton Valley's KVHS radio station.





The strong Eagle team went on to close out the league season with a 4 win 3 loss record. Highlighting the season was the 34-10 victory over Ygnacio Valley for the Axe. Their 25-21 victory over Mt. Diablo finished the season on a good note. This was Coach Pete Carpino's first year as head coach of the Eagles. He did a fine job in building "team" morale. A great deal of credit is to be given to coach Roger Zino and coach Larry Fogelstrom, be-cause, as Coach Carpino puts it, "They cannot be given enough credit for the fine job they did in coaching the offensive and defensive team this year." 



























#### Homecoming























#### Assemblies






#### Paper Drive



#### **Tennis**




This year the tennis team was coached by Jim Henderson, an alumni of Clayton Valley.


Seniors this year were Mike Hotaling, Bruce Ajari, and Mike Segale.



























Other than swimming and track, gymnastics develops the total body, as well as advancing creativity, grace and poise.


Gymnastics includes the use of such apparatus as the balance beam, free exercise, the horse, parallel bars, the tramp and tumbling.
































#### Arsenic And Old Lace

"Arsenic and Old Lace." was given for both students and the public and was enjoyed by all,


































#### K.V.H.S. Dance

KVHS received a profit of over three hundred dollars, which went toward the purchase of a tape recorder used for broadcasting.









A special thanks went to Mr. Trueblood, drama instructor, Mr. Spoor, music director and a presentation of flowers went to Miss Cartwright, choral director.









# InterclubsAssembly



### FROSH DANCE





















The Eagles had a 5-3 record in pre-league competition with Bob Thomason scoring an all-time school high of 42 points against Del Valle.


In the Del Valle Tournament the Eagles finished third with their only loss a double overtime thriller against De Anza 65-62.


In the Camellia Tournament the Eagles finished fourth after defeating a much taller Edison team 82-72 in the first round of play.







# 2 Yrs. Undefeated Wrestlers




Coach Roger Zino's varsity wrestling team began its most successful season by taking first place at the Del Valle Invitational Tournament for the second time in three years.


The 1966-67 wrestling squad also took first in its league with a record of 14-0 for the second year in a row while running its consecutive win streak in dual matches to 30.





In spite of bad weather during various activities, those members of the class who were willing to work had loads of fun.








#### Tiare-Tahiti







Everyone who worked on the prom deserves a big THANKS for making this night the success it was.










Hooten anny

Some of the performers were in a beat group called the Surplus Overlap. Several individual folk singing groups participated. The master of ceremonies was Carrol Shearer '67.



All in all the hootenanny was a complete success thanks to the help of the advisors Mr. Kennett, Mr. Petullo, and Rootie Kazoo.





















### Donkey Basketball



# Expialodochis Class Play





Congratulations to the Seniors for a job well done.















#### TRACK 67

The Junior Varsity-Eagles also had an outstanding season, being league champions with a record of 15-1.






## Spirit Of 67









## SWIMMING TEAM

























## Girls Assembly
